COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

FALL SEMESTER: 12 Credit Hours

BIBL 101 Genesis: The Foundation

An examination of the Book of Genesis with emphasis on the development, themes and major Christian doctrines. Particular focus relating to Creation, the Fall, The Great Universal Flood, destruction of Sodom, and the call of Abraham. Concentration for the particular focus will relate to the first twelve chapters of Genesis and their relation to current cultural trends today in society.

THEO 101 Principles of Faith

This course explains the primary Christian doctrines and beliefs that undergird the Old and New Testaments and are the basis of individual faith in Christianity. These form the basis for sanctification and continued growth in the faith.

THEO 112 Spiritual Maturity

This course helps the student understand the authority that God has given them as a believer and challenges them to walk in that authority in their daily lives.

THEO 311 Evangelism Today

This course inspires and equips students to share the Gospel one-on-one with those in their circle of influence. Students will discover their own "style" of evangelism and develop their personal testimony into an effective witnessing tool.

SPRING SEMESTER: 12 Credit Hours

THEO 103 Ministry of Helps

This course assists the student in understanding the value of serving in the Body of Christ and helps them find their place of service.

THEO 305 Understanding People

This course combines the rigorous formal study of developmental issues with our own observations and thorough study of Scripture, to truly understand working with people. An appreciation for the intricacies of growth and development positively influences every person we contact.

BIBL 302 Biblical Leadership

This course will help the student to grasp a New Testament picture of leadership that is person centered, and team centered. Rather than basing ministry on secular principles, the timeless biblical strategies of placing people to use their gifts in service will help you grow in self-perception, skills, and vision as a leader.
